1. The Award

The **NY Firefighters Bravest Federal Credit Union Scholarship** is an award to be paid to the student or educational institution.

2. Eligibility

The applicant must be a member in good standing with the credit union and meet all the following criteria:

- **a**. The member must be a college bound high school senior at the time of application.
- **b**. The member will be attending college for the first time in the fall.
- **c**. The member will be enrolled in either a two or four year accredited educational institution.
- **d**. The members agrees to use any scholarship funds awarded only at an accredited educational institution by January of the following year.
